STUDENT'S STABBING DEATH

After gaming back control, school gets 2 more notices

'Discrepancies' flagged; school asked to respond by May 25 & 29

MONTHS AFTER one of its students died in a stabbing incident, a private school, whose management was given back to it recently, has been served two show-cause notices for 'discrepancies' in information it had shared with government authorities.

This development comes after advocate general (AG) Kamal Trivedi, on April 28, informed the Gujarat High Court that the state would be withdrawing its December order taking over the school's management.

In August last year, a Class 10 student, who was enrolled at the school's Maninagar campus, died after being stabbed by a schoolmate. Following the incident, the school management was issued several show-cause notices.

The fresh notices on the minority school, which has two campuses in Harijara (Kokhara) and Maninagar, were issued by the Director, Primary Education and the Gujarat Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board (GSHSEB) on May 14 and 16, respectively. The school has been asked to respond to them by May 25 and 29.

Citing the Mumbai Primary Education Rules, 1949 and the Gujarat Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Act, 1972, one of the notices seeks information on the 'approval from competent authorities' to run two schools—at Harijara and Maninagar (near Church)—and additional classes.

The notices have also sought details of the minority character of the school and clarity on the trust that manages the school, which "is not clear".

The documents submitted to the district education officer mentioned "The India Financial Association of Seventh Day

Adventists', 'The Council of Seventh-Day Adventist Educational Institutions' and 'Ashlok Education Trust', one of the notices said.

As per a letter shared by the school on June 12, 2025, informing students about the admission process for the academic year 2025-26, there are two schools mentioned—Harijara Campus and Maninagar Campus. Whether approval/certificate has been obtained for both these schools? If not, why should legal action not be taken... it added.

Also, there are 'discrepancies' in terms of the school's location.

The management has also been asked to submit details of its CISCE affiliation, allowing it to run classes from IX to XII in Maninagar.

The Maninagar campus has more than 10,000 students enrolled in its primary and secondary sections. While the school is affiliated to CISCE for Classes 1 to 12, it also has the state board's approval to run the science stream for students of Classes 11 and 12.

has demanded information on whether any prior approval of the competent authority to run the school in two shifts was obtained.

"Who is the owner... and if there is a rental agreement other than the lease deed... The land on which the school is situated was donated by Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation to The India Financial Association of Seventh Day Adventists for educational purposes. The school is managed by a separate organisation named 'The Council of Seventh-Day Adventist Educational Institutions/Ashlok Education Trust'. As per CISCE rules, the school should be managed by a single registered society, trust or company that is not run for profit motive," it added.

Other details sought are the building plan, building use permit (BUP), and fire NOC. Meanwhile, the school management has also been accused of violating the Gujarat Self-Financed Schools (Regulation of Fees) Act, 2017, which prohibits profiteering from selling books on school premises.

AMC installs 12 girders of Makarba bridge in 4 days; launch in July

AHMEDABAD MUNICIPAL CORPORATION (AMC) has completed the installation of 12 steel composite girders of the Makarba Bridge's railway line portion on the Sarkhej Gandhinagar Highway in a "record four days", officials said.

The 640-metre long and 16.4 metre wide overbridge, being built jointly by AMC and the Railways at an estimated cost of Rs 75 crore, is expected to ease daily traffic congestion on the SO Highway as well as Vejalpur Corporate Road, benefiting over a lakh daily commuters. The

commuters especially in West Ahmedabad, Makarba, Vejalpur Corporate Road and SO Highway areas will be relieved of daily traffic chaos once the bridge is opened, officials said.

"We have installed the steel girders within four days. The project, being built at a 50:50 cost sharing basis between the AMC and the Railways, is expected to open for the public in the first week of July," Engineer Shree, Deputy City Engineer, said.

Officials said AMC is speeding up the work on Makarba Bridge. The railway line block was given to the AMC by the Railways on May 18. Fol-

lowing this, the work of installing 12 steel composite girders was completed by the AMC. "This work has been completed on time by the Engineering Department of the AMC in coordination with the Railways. With the completion of the girder launching on the bridge, the work of the next phase will pick up," the officials added.

Man poses as deputy SP to cheat citizens, arrested

Surentrangan: A man was arrested in Surendranagar in Gujarat for allegedly posing as a deputy superintendent of police, an official said on Sunday.

Sohikhan Pathan (31), a resident of Sayla here, was held by a Rajkot Range police team for creating this false identity to allegedly commit cybercrimes and cheat people, an official release said.

Pathan created fake documents, photographs and ID cards using electronic devices to gain financial benefits and shared them on social media, it said. A case has been registered under BNS and the IT Act against him at Sayla police station, it added.

Bank staffer held for stealing Rs 8.7 cr from currency chest in Ahmedabad

Ahmedabad: An employee of a public sector bank was arrested in Gujarat's Ahmedabad for allegedly smuggling Rs 8.7 crore out of an RBI currency chest and laundering the stolen money into properties and cryptocurrency, police said Sunday.

Acting on a tip-off, the police apprehended the accused, Harisiddh Kadiyar, a junior cus-

tomian with the Bank of Baroda, who executed the multi-crore theft on January 13 after tracking him down to the Sola area on Friday, Assistant Commissioner of Police D Division Hitendra Chaudhary said.

Kadiyar has been remained in police custody until May 27, he said.

The official said that the accused was a junior joint custodian

of the Bank of Baroda's Gandhinagar branch in the Kalupur area, which houses a Reserve Bank of India (RBI) currency chest.

According to police, Kadiyar, along with two contract labourers, allegedly smuggled the cash out of the bank under the guise of disposing of used iron boxes. However, the boxes were allegedly filled with cur-

rency notes worth Rs 8.7 crore. The accused continued to report for work until April 20 to avoid suspicion, assuming that the CCTV footage capturing the theft would be automatically deleted after 90 days.

He later disappeared and went on prolonged sick leave, ACP Chaudhary said. He said the theft came to light during a routine verifica-

tion ahead of an RBI inspection after a newly appointed in-charge of the currency chest noticed the missing currency notes.

An FIR was registered at the Kalupur police station on May 15, he said.

The police have recovered Rs 2.2 crore in cash from the boot of a car parked at the spot where Kadiyar was arrested.

During interrogation, Kadiyar confessed to using part of the stolen money to purchase a house in Chandkheda, a commercial village, and a shop in Ahmedabad.

He also allegedly gave Rs 23 lakh to a female colleague for purchasing a house and handed over an additional Rs 5 lakh in cash to her, police said.
